



Post Medlite Laser Skin Renewal/ Pigment Treatment Instructions

- Avoid direct sunlight to the treated area for 14 days. Direct application of sunscreen, SPF 15 or greater, is recommended in the area of treatment.
- If having a series of treatments, sun exposure should be avoided between treatments.
- For the first 7 days following treatment:
 - AM: wash with a mild cleanser, moisturizer, and apply sunblock (make-up if desired)
 - PM: wash with a mild cleanser and apply moisturizer
 - You may resume your normal skin care routine starting day 7.
- The treated area must be treated with care. Do not pick, or scratch at your skin.
- A mild sunburn-like sensation is expected. This usually lasts 2 – 24 hours but can persist up to 72 hours.
- Post treatment discomfort you may use oral pain relievers-Tylenol, Advil, Ibuprofen.
- You may experience a deep red / bruise-like discoloration on the treated area which may persist up to 14 days.
- Initially, a darker pigmentation will likely occur. This will dissipate over the next 7-14 days.
- Apply cool / ice compress to the area treated for 10-15 minutes every hour for the first 4 hours after laser treatment to reduce discomfort and heat sensation.
- If blistering occurs, apply Vaseline and call our office.
- Until redness has completely resolved (approximately 5-7 days), avoid all of the following:
 - Swimming, especially in pools with chemicals / chlorine
 - Hot tubs and Jacuzzis
 - Activities that cause excessive perspiration
 - Scrubs, loofas
